

## **Report under Section 22 of the Protected Disclosures Act 2014 for the period:**

## 1 January 2017 to 31 December 2017

The Protected Disclosures Act 2014 is intended to provide a robust statutory framework to protect workers who raise concerns regarding potential wrongdoing (whistleblowers) that has come to their attention in the workplace.

Section 22 of the <u>Protected Disclosures Act, 2014</u> requires the publication of an Annual Report, by public bodies, relating to (a) the number of Protected Disclosures received in the preceding year and (b) any actions taken in response to the Protected Disclosures made.

This is the 2017 annual report of the Valuation Office under Section 22 of the Act. It covers the period 1 January 2017 to 31 December 2017.

No protected disclosures were received from workers of the Valuation Office in the period covered by this report.
